

The NHG General Surgery Residency Programme seeks applicants who demonstrate the following essential qualities:

Base Criteria

1. Clinical Competence

- a) Medical Knowledge: Demonstrate a strong understanding of basic and clinical sciences.
- b) **Problem-solving Ability**: Take initiative to troubleshoot problems.
- c) Manual Dexterity: Exhibit coordination, precision and control in handling surgical equipment.
- d) **Performance:** Show good work performance and receive positive feedback in medical student, house officer and/ or medical officer postings.

2. Interpersonal and Communication Skills

- a) **Communication:** Exhibit effective and clear communication with patients, their family members as well as other healthcare professionals.
- b) **Teamwork and Collegiality:** Demonstrate the ability to work well and collaborate with other healthcare professionals, including nursing, allied health and administrative teams.

3. Professionalism

- a) Work Ethic and Attitude: Hardworking and collegial.
- b) Integrity and Accountability: Maintain high standards of integrity and accountability at work.
- c) **Conscientiousness:** Show diligence in completing tasks, such as administrative and clinical work, in a timely manner.

4. Personal Attributes

- a) Kindness and Compassion
- b) Situational Awareness
- c) Decision-making
- d) Leadership
- e) Resilience
- f) Teachable
- g) **Passion and Commitment:** Show dedication to completing the General Surgery Residency Programme.

Optional Criteria

5. Clinical Experience in Relevant Postings

a) Experience as a medical student, house officer or medical officer in General Surgery.

6. Research Experience

a) Research Participation: Involvement in research and/or quality improvement projects.

7. Examination Components

a) Has attempted parts of MRCS or its equivalent.

Candidates who meet the base and/or optional criteria are eligible to apply for residency training. However, meeting the eligibility criteria does not guarantee a match.
